Well, the second time is the charm, after our first attempt was cancelled due to weather concerns. October 9th arrived bright and beautiful for the 16 members in 7 Bonanzas as well as a beautiful Comanche 400.



Paul Henderson, KOSA's Airport Manager and his team, greeted us into their terminal building for lunch prepared by the local Creative Catering. The home style service featured choices of Parmesan Crusted Chicken Breasts and Pork Tenderloin with Raspberry Chipotle, complete with all the fixin's.

Once fed, we were in for the real treat of a private tour of Mid-American Flight Museum, one of the best kept secrets in the country. Paul led the tour along with museum associates James and Andrew. Prominently setting on the ramp is their newest acquisition, one of only

approximately 8 flying examples, the B-17H Thunder Bird. It will soon be heading to the West Coast for some specific maintenance and hopes to be returned in about 6 months. Thunder Bird joins the nearly 50 flying examples of the American air industry generally from the 1920s through the 1950s.



After stopping at their newest member, we started our tour with the normally off-limits maintenance hangar. Currently their restoration focus is on the completion of a super rare Grumman Duck, this one has the added historical significance of being a Pearl Harbor survivor. It was joined with its stable mates including 2 T28s, a P-40 as well as (Beechcraft tie-in) a T-34C.
